Bios:

William Gibson (Book) wrote poetry, fiction, and scripts for stage, television, and films. His plays include The Miracle Worker (Tony Award, Best Play 1960); Two for the Seesaw; Golda; The Butterfingers Angel: Monday After the Miracle; Googly Creatures; and Handy Dandy. He wrote the musical version of Clifford Odets' Golden Boy. His several books include "The Seesaw Log:" "A Mass for the Dead": a volume of poetry entitled "Winter Crook": and "A Season in Heaven," which takes a look at metaphysics and the creative process. He was married to the psychoanalyst Margaret Brenman-Gibson, whose biography, "Clifford Odets, American Playwright," appeared in 1982.

Joe Raposo (Music and Lyrics), one of the creators of "Sesame Street" and the program's first musical director, began his theatrical career at the Hasty Pudding Club at Harvard College. After graduation, he studied composition with Nadia Boulanger in Paris. Mr. Raposo collaborated on the score to You're a Good Man Charlie Brown. His songs, recorded by Kermit the Frog, Frank Sinatra, Ray Charles and Barbra Streisand, include "Sing," "It's Not Easy Being Green," "Here's to the Winners" and "America is." He has produced several gold and platinum records, and won a number of Grammys, Emmys and an Oscar nomination for his music to The Great Muppet Caper.

Gwyneth "Gwyn" Gaunt (Founder, Artistic Director, Composer, Revisions, Producer, Director, Music Director) is a second year BFA musical theatre major, and is so proud of this cast and crew for making her four-year dream come to life in just two weeks. You may have already seen her as #00 (The Wolves, LFC), Anne Egerman (A Little Night Music, OU SOT), or Cosmia (Sense of Right, a lab show by Michael Mylen). She hopes you enjoy the first (legal) production of Rag Dolly: The Raggedy Ann Musical since 1986, and thanks you for being a part of this show's history.
